
"Country Walks" Scout Hill with Peasey Beck

 $5\frac{1}{2}$ miles: Allow 3 hours

Stout footwear is recommended

Start & finish at the

"Old School Gallery & Tea Room" Preston Patrick, Crooklands, Nr. Kendal.



Start the walk from the main A65 road in front of the **Old School Gallery & Tea Room**.

- 1. With the Old School Gallery on your left and the Memorial Hall over on your right, immediately turn left onto a lane by the side of the Old School Gallery signposted [Friends Meeting House & Goose Green]. Follow the lane for just under ¼ mile, then, (opposite a house on your left) turn right signposted [Public Footpath], and cross over the flat stone bridge to enter a field.
- 2. Aim towards the motorway and in the very far left-land corner of this field (approx. 350yds away) go through a large gate. Immediately turn right and pass through another gate to enter a tunnel underneath the M6 motorway. On the opposite side of the motorway, proceed straight across a field for 50yds, to climb over a stone-stile. In the next field, walk alongside the right-hand wall/hedge for 250yds, to arrive at a lane. Turn left and follow this lane (through the small hamlet of Black Yeats) for just under ½ mile, to reach a T-junction with another lane.
- **3.** Turn right and proceed for 150yds, then turn left onto a double-rutted track, signposted [Public Bridleway] Gradually ascend for just over ¼ mile, to reach a point where the track turns sharp left (next to a gate & field on your right). Continue uphill for a further 350yds, to pass through a gate across the route. Proceed up the double-rutted track for a further 150yds, to link up with a wall on your right. Important: Walk alongside this wall on your right for a further 200yds, to arrive at a gate on the edge of a field.

- **4.** Go through the gate, and immediately **turn left** to pass through another large gate [*Public Bridleway*]. With the summit of *Scout Hill* up on your right (926 ft), go straight ahead and walk alongside the wall on your left for ½ mile, to pass through a gate across the route. Aim towards another gate seen 200yds away, then <u>continue parallel</u> to the <u>left-hand wall</u> for another ½ mile, (see map) to eventually link up with a lane.
- **5. Turn left** and follow this narrow lane for just over 1 mile, to cross a bridge over the M6 motorway. Continue for a further ¼ mile, to reach a T-junction with another lane.
- **6.** Turn left and proceed for ½ mile, then turn 1st right onto another narrow lane situated in the small hamlet of Kaker Mill. Follow this lane for 275yds, to cross over a large bridge spanning the fast-flowing river known as *Peasey Beck.* On the opposite side of the bridge, proceed for a maximum of 20yds, then turn left through a squeeze-stile by the side of a large gate, signposted [*Public Footpath Crooklands ½ mile*] to enter a field.
- **7.** Go straight ahead, parallel to the right-hand hedge for 350yds, then cross over a stile next to a gate. **Bear left** and within 50yds, the path forks. **Bear left again**, and, crossing over numerous stiles along the route, follow the line of the *Peasey Beck* on your left for just under ½ mile, then pass between the buildings and cottages that once formed part of Crooklands Bobbin Mill, to link up with the main A65 road. **Turn left** and where possible, follow the roadside footpath to return to the **Old School Gallery & Tea Room**. ©
